The Regular Monthly Meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Stowe was held on Tuesday, March 12, 2019, in the Municipal Building, 555 Broadway Avenue, Mc Kees Rocks, PA 15136.

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m. by President Papst, who led in the Pledge of Allegiance, then a Moment of Silence in honor of all Veterans and First Responders.

A Brief Executive Session was motioned by Commissioner McDermott and seconded by Cropper-Hall, the Board returned at 7:08 p.m.

ROLL CALL: Present were Commissioners Parrilla, Cropper-Hall, Derzic, Papst, McDermott, and Chestnutt, Putas, and Faloshey. Absent were Commissioner Hoffman. Also, present were Solicitor Gary Matta, Township Engineer Veronica Bennett, and Secretary Nicholas Martini.

Comments from Commissioners:

Commissioner Cropper-Hall had questions regarding the Sheriff sale process for Solicitor Matta explained the process as well as how Tax and sewage collections would take place. Also mentioned was the placing of a new telephone tower on Valley Street, Solicitor Matta will look into this matter.

ENGINEERS REPORT: Engineer Bennett presented her written report discussed the following items: Ridge Ave Demolition project should be underway very soon just awaiting the contractor to have equipment on site, The Pittsburgh Curling Club conditional use permit meeting will take place on April 9th, the Fleming Avenue Stormwater Improvement Project, The tunnel way project grant extension approved, The Elizabeth Ave cleanup project drilling and work began on March 8th, the RoadBotics Update, ALCOSAN regionalization project, MS4 permit, Allegheny Places SALDO grant, PA Water and Sewer Grant extension was approved, and the Act 167 stormwater management grant.
