

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE  
TOWNSHIP OF STOWE, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA,  
HELD ON TUESDAY, April 9, 2019, IN THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING,  
555 BROADWAY AVENUE, MC KEES ROCKS, PA 15136.**

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The Regular Monthly Meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Stowe was held on Tuesday, April 9, 2019, in the Municipal Building, 555 Broadway Avenue, Mc Kees Rocks, PA 15136.

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m. by President Papst, who led in the Pledge of Allegiance, then a Moment of Silence in honor of all Veterans and First Responders.

**ROLL CALL:** Present were Commissioners Parrilla, Cropper-Hall, Derzic, Papst, McDermott, and Chestnutt, Hoffman, and Putas. Absent were Commissioner Faloshey. Also, present were Solicitor Bradley Matta, Township Engineer Veronica Bennett, and Secretary Nicholas Martini.

A brief Zoning hearing was held to approve the conditional use permit for the Pittsburgh Curling Club on McCoy Road. No citizen comments. Motion to approve by Cropper-Hall second by Hoffman. Vote to approve was 8-0 with all Commissioners voting Yes.

**COMMENTS OF CITIZENS:** Sam Nucci from Ingram Borough, and the Char-West COG was on hand to discuss the proposed intergovernmental Cooperation agreement to share services for ordinances, documents, and to set up a zoning appeals board with shared officers. Questions were asked from Commissioners McDermott and Cropper-Hall on the need for this and how this is different from our own Zoning board.

**ENGINEERS REPORT:** Engineer Bennett presented her written report discussed the following items: Ridge Ave Demolition project should be underway very soon just awaiting the contractor to have equipment on site, should begin to move equipment in April 11-13, The Pittsburgh Curling Club conditional use permit meeting took place on April 9<sup>th</sup> and was approved, the Fleming Avenue Stormwater Improvement Project, The tunnel way project grant extension approved, The Elizabeth Ave cleanup project drilling and work began on March 8<sup>th</sup> and are awaiting final estimates from Ackenheil engineers, the RoadBotics Update, ALCOSAN regionalization project, MS4 permit needs to be advertised for a brief hearing to solicit citizen comments, Allegheny Places SALDO grant, PA Water and Sewer Grant extension was approved, and the Act 167 stormwater management grant.
