

**REORGANIZATION MEETING, MONDAY, JANUARY 6, 2020**

The reorganization meeting was held on Monday, January 6, 2020, in the Municipal Building, 555 Broadway Avenue, McKees Rocks, PA 15136. Secretary Martini called the meeting to order and lead in the Pledge of Allegiance.

**CANDIDATES SWORN IN:** District Judge Bruce Boni presided over the swearing in ceremony and congratulated the elected officials. Sworn in were Commissioners Cheryl McDermott Kelly Cropper Hall, and David Rugh, as well as Tax Collector/Treasurer William Rose.

**ROLL CALL:** Present for roll call was Commissioners Derzic, Chestnutt, Rugh, McDermott, Cropper Hall, and Parrilla. Commissioner Faloshey was absent. Secretary Martini was present.

**NEWSPAPER:** Motion by McDermott second by Parrilla appointing Gazette 2.0 and Post-Gazette as the official newspapers of Stowe Township was unanimously approved.

**SOLICITORS:** Motion by Cropper-Hall second by McDermott appointing Dodaro Matta & Cambest was unanimously approved.

**ENGINEERS:** Motion by McDermott second by Chestnutt appointing KLH Engineers was unanimously approved.

**FIRE CHIEF:** Motion by McDermott second by Parrilla appointing Dave Gallagher as the Chief of the Stowe Township Volunteer Fire Department was unanimously approved.

President Parrilla Thanked Stowe Township and the Board of Commissioners for their confidence in him to lead, President Parrilla stated he is a lifelong resident, and honored to be board President, the board is now down to 7 Commissioners, and will be down to 5 by 2022 all voted on at-large.
